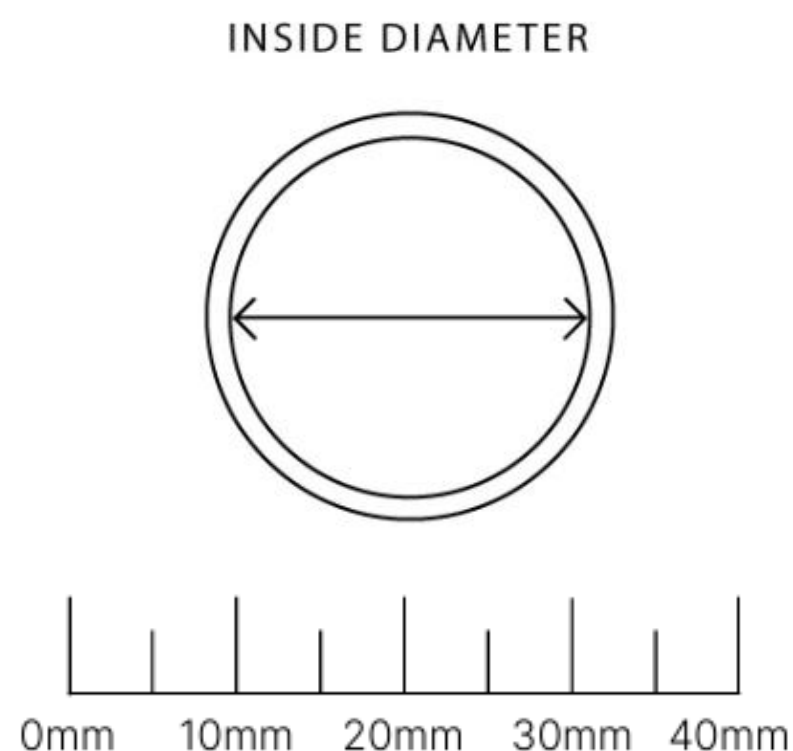


A GUIDE TO MEASURING RINGS

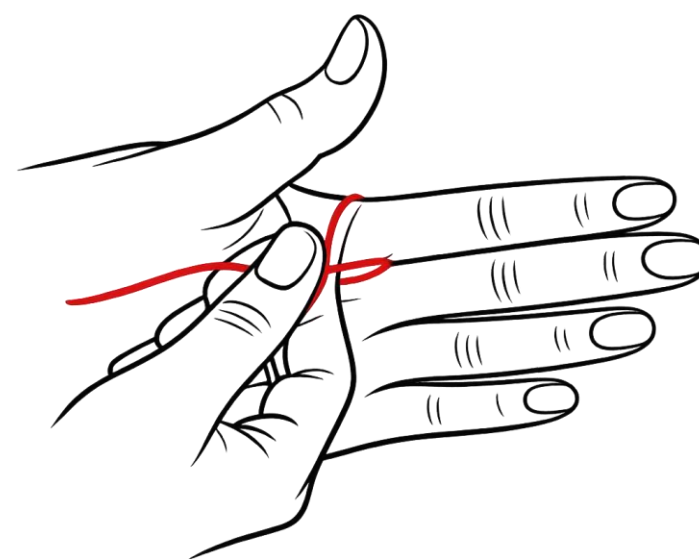
Method 1 – Measure using your own ring

- Select a ring that fits your finger perfectly.
- Measure the inside diameter of the ring.
- Use the chart below to determine which ring size would be perfect for you.



Method 2 – Measure using a string

- Wrap a piece of string around your finger.
- Ensure the string is wrapped comfortably.
- Mark where the ends of the string meet with a pen.
- Lay the string on a flat surface and measure the length. (in mm)
- This will give you the circumference of the ring.
- Use the chart below to determine which ring size would be perfect for you.



Use the Ring Size Chart below to determine your ring size:
